



## **Jersey Audit Office - Privacy Policy**

### **Your personal information and what we collect**

We do not capture or store any personal information about you when you access our website, except where you voluntarily choose to give us your personal details by email.

### **What we do with the information we gather**

We do not share the information you provide with any third parties and we protect it in accordance with the Data Protection (Jersey) Law 2018.

### **Cookies**

We use cookies on our website. Cookies are small files which can be stored on your computer when you visit a website. These files contain information about the webpages you look at so that the next time you visit the site it can be customised to meet your needs.

Most browsers support cookies but you can set your browser to decline them and delete them whenever you like. However, some functions of our website may not work as they should if cookies are not enabled.
