



Appointment of Affiliates to support the work of the Comptroller and Auditor General

The Comptroller and Auditor General (C&AG) wishes to appoint approximately 10 Affiliates to assist in the delivery of a range of reviews/ projects for the period November 2013 – October 2015 (with an option to extend in annual increments for a further two years).

This opportunity is for four specialist roles:

- Investigations
- Healthcare
- IS/IT
- Housing.

It is anticipated that a number of other engagement exercises will be undertaken during 2014 and 2015.

The Affiliates will be individual 'specialists' in specific disciplines and it is not expected that multi- disciplinary organisations will be appointed for this work.

The objective is to create a pool of 'approved' professional, experienced people who will be required to complete project work within a specified time period to an agreed standard and cost.

Where appropriate the C&AG will utilise 'on Island' resources for data collection. The Affiliates will use the data together with interviews, research and analysis to draft reports on behalf of the C&AG. The objective being to use appropriate resources for the tasks required ensuring value for money and a cost effective service. From time to time individual Affiliates may be required to work as part of a multidisciplinary team.

There will be no guarantee of work for any individual.

The selection of and management of the Affiliates will be undertaken by the C&AG. The closing date for proposals is 9 October 2013 (5pm).
